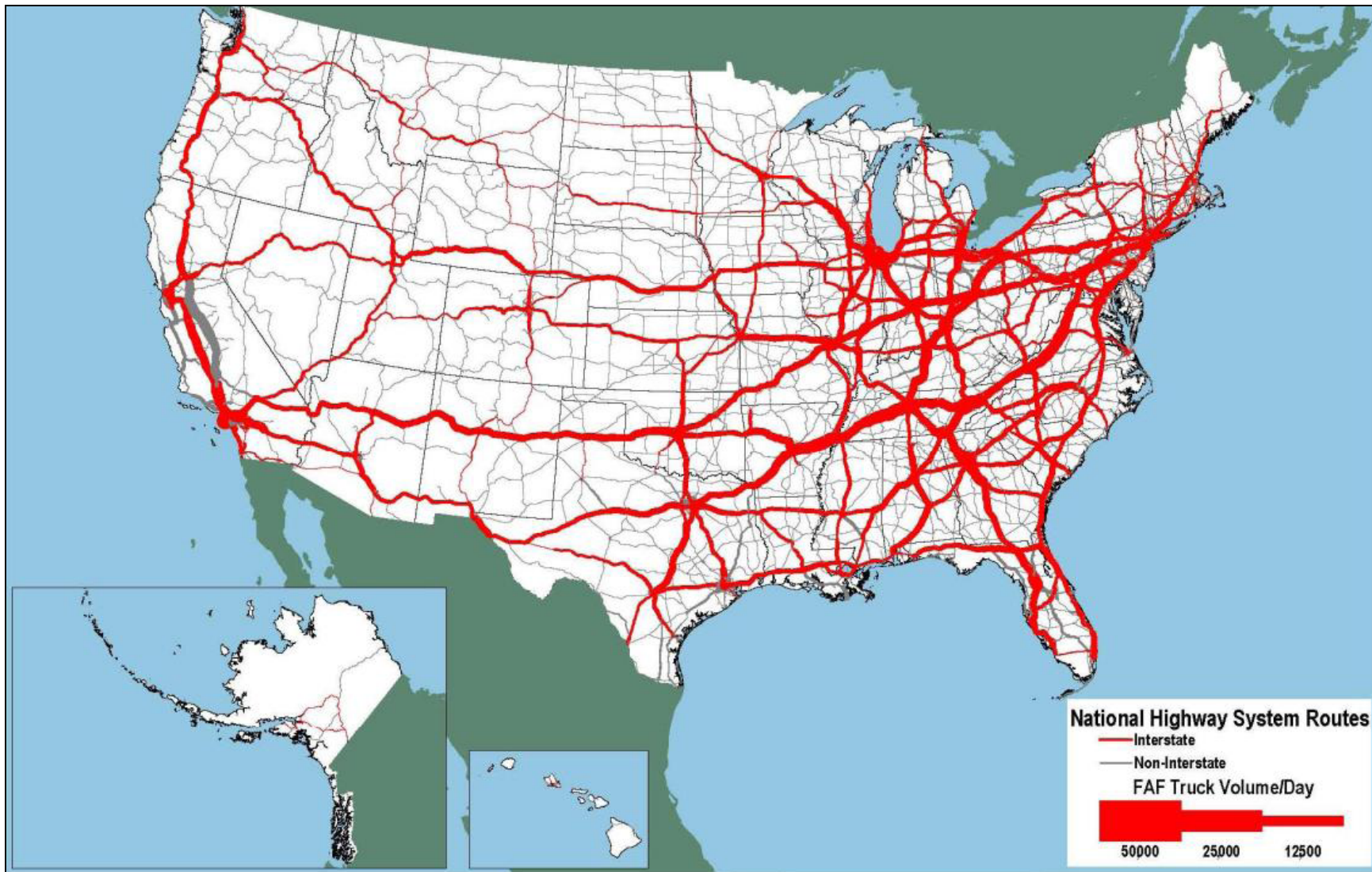


Figure 4-19: Average Daily Long-Haul Freight Truck Traffic on National Highway System in 2002
